### SAT | OCT 24 | 7 PM

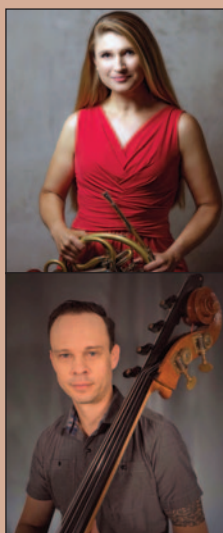
#### Ching-Yi Lin, violin and Andrew Braddock, viola
